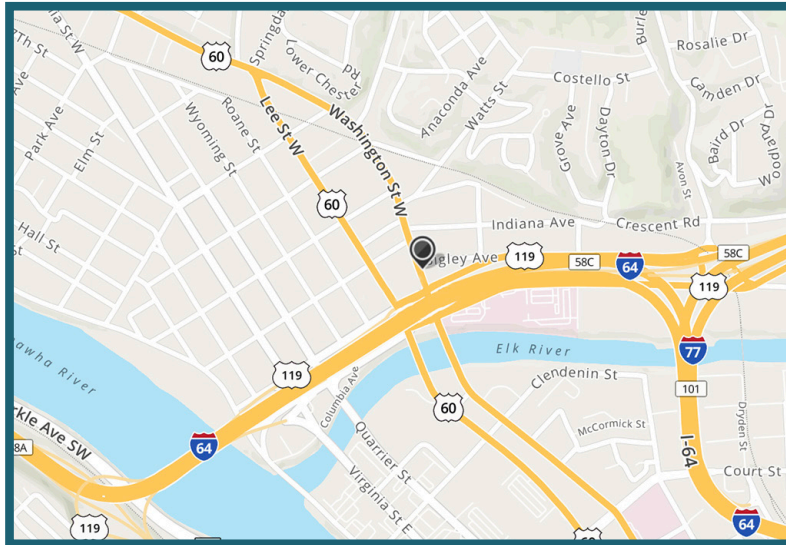

Instructions for Semen Analysis or Sperm Prep

Scheduling:

1. All specimens that arrive at Carolinas Fertility Institute must have an appointment.
2. All referral specimens must be accompanied by your physician's prescription. Orders can be faxed to our office or brought with you the day of your appointment. Test results will be sent to your referring provider via fax within 5 business days.

General Collection Guidelines:

1. Proper picture identification is required for all patients providing a semen specimen.
2. For best results, please maintain a window of abstinence for at least 2 days, but no more than 5 days.
3. The semen specimen may be collected at home or in the clinic collection room. If the specimen is collected at home, it must arrive at the laboratory within one hour of collection. Specimens should be collected into a sterile container with a screw-on lid.
4. The sample should be kept between room and body temperature (70 – 98.6°F).



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
